### A Speedy Turtle

The Texas 89<sup>th</sup> Legislature is now in full swing down in Austin. If you are listening, you will certainly have heard that it is moving like molasses, and good bills are getting killed, and bad bills are getting passed. In reality, that is how the legislative process is designed. Let's take these one at a time.

The process is designed to move like molasses. There are two chambers, the House and the Senate with about 30 committees on each side. Bills may be filed between a date in December following the election up until a deadline of the 60<sup>th</sup> day of session, March 14 this session. Members must be assigned to committees which takes time to balance the workload. Senate committees are easy because of smaller numbers, only 16 new Senators. The House has 150 new members each session. This session, committee assignments were announced on February 23, the latest date in 45 years. Beginning February 24, filed bills started getting a first reading on the floor of the House and were then referred to committee. By March 14 there were just short of 6,300 bills filed, and 2,500 had been read and referred to committee. As of March 29, just over 4,200 bills have been read and referred.

Once referred to a committee, the bill must be scheduled for a public hearing in that committee. The committees only have time to meet nine to fifteen times during the session. There will be well over 100 bills in every committee with some reaching as high as 800. There isn't enough time especially where some bills get hours of public testimony. The bill must then be voted favorably out of committee and sent to Calendars to be scheduled for a floor debate and vote. Bills with the greatest likelihood of passing on the floor get priority. If passed on the floor of the House, the process must be repeated by the Senate. If successful in both places, the Governor must sign it.

Let's speak of GOOD bills vs. BAD bills. Good and bad are in the eye of the writer and proponent. In order to make its way through the above process, one must have a majority of the committee members think its not that bad, the Calendars Committee believe it has a high chance of passage, and 76 votes on the House floor and 16 on the Senate floor. In order for many people to believe it's not too bad, most of us will need to accept compromise. Here is where PERFECT becomes the ENEMY OF THE GOOD.

Right now, tax payer funds are used to lobby against tax payers, anyone from hostile countries can buy up Texas land, and no one can set up an education savings account. There are many more items and priorities to be dealt with as well. If there is no compromise, the status quo remains. If there is compromise, we get some portion of what we want with a chance to make it better in coming sessions. It is NOT all or nothing, it is something or nothing.





### Power to the People

In the democratic republic known as these United States, the political power of the people is largely expressed at the ballot box. Never is your vote more powerful than during a Primary Election. Let me explain.

When turnout is low in an election, those who *do* vote are more influential than those voting in a high turnout election. It's simple math. If 1,000 voters turn out, each voter is responsible for one tenth of one percent of the vote. If only 100 voters turn out, each voter is responsible for one full percent. That's ten times greater! If your monthly income were to increase tenfold, you would notice. The truth is, Primary elections notoriously experience a low turnout.

Why is that? There are two main reasons. First the date of a Primary Election is somewhat fluid. General Elections are always held the Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even numbered years. It's easy to calculate and 100% predictable. Whereas Primary Elections are usually held within 6 to 9 months before the General election with the Iowa Caucus and the New Hampshire Primary traditionally going first. That's right, unlike the General Election, the Primaries are held in different states on different days, giving candidates more time to campaign in each state. The order in which Primaries are held in each state varies after that somewhat whimsically. There have even been cases where the Democrat and Republican Primaries within a state have been held on different days! Goodness, no wonder they are confusing and result in lower turnout.

The second reason is the mistaken impression that the Primary is not the "real election." After all, "the President is elected in the General Election." However, it is in the Primary where that Presidential candidate is chosen. If you wait for the General, there is no real choice. You would choose AOC over *which* Republican Candidate? Personally, I'd write in my cat before I'd vote for a Democrat. Their political philosophy is antithetical to everything the Founders stood for. Their every policy has been corrosive to the Liberty guaranteed by our Constitution.

In the Primary, you have a real choice from among the best Republican candidates. And, because of the chronic low turnout in Primary Elections, this is when your vote will be most impactful. Of course, the trick is to know when and where the Primary Election is held. Look for the signs. Campaigns will be heating up. You will find the debates and best commentary right here.
