Or a war is imminent in oil producing areas and is likely to drive up the price of gas and heating oil – stock up if you can and retool your budget for the foreseeable future. Pray for the innocent lives.

This distinguished useful news from emotional voyeuristic news, like a child in Argentina falls into a well and rescue efforts are prolonged because of soil issues. Although such stories tug at our heartstrings, unless it inspires you to cover a well on your own property, it is unlikely to have any impact on your personal life. These stories are the “Tella Novella” of life, fodder for workplace conversations but little more. Responsible news agencies might run such stories on slow news days.

If the news you watch was for weeks non-stop covering the Nancy Guthrie kidnapping (we pray for her safe return) and little else, it is not a responsible news organization. These were not slow news days! These are lazy people who entertain you for ratings. They cover such stories not only because it is salacious, but because it is so easy. National news agencies will have personnel in the area. Everyone involved speaks English. Access to physical locations and individuals involved is unrestricted. Cheap and easy! They don't cover the more difficult, less palatable stories. They *cover them up*.

Where was the news about the growing and on-going revolution in Iran? It is hard to get information, much less video, out of a police state.

Primary Candidates:

There are too many candidates to list on the March Primary ballot. Do your research early. Attend the candidate forums. Don't vote on name recognition alone. A number of well known names are running for positions they have never held before. This is the most important Primary in many years. Remember, we are in the new Congressional District 32.

On the ballot we have 8 candidates for US Senator, 9 for US Rep. in the newly created district 32. 11 For Texas Governor, 4 for Lt. Governor, 4 for Attorney General, 4 for Comptroller, 2 for Ag commissioner, 5 for the surprisingly important Rail Road Commissioner, Court of Criminal appeals #3, 4 candidates, #9 2 candidates. State board of Education place #9 has 3 candidates and Texas HD 5 has 2 candidates.

Local races in the County: 2 candidates for District Attorney, 2 for County Treasurer, 2 for Precinct 4 County Commissioner, 2 for Justice of the Peace Pct 2, 3 for JP Pct 3, 2 for Constable Pct 2.

In most of these races there is at least one really good candidate, sometimes two. This is a Primary election. This is your opportunity to exchange a disappointing incumbent for a promising new candidate. This is your chance to truly make a difference. Don't sit this one out. The candidates you choose in this Primary will face a much less attractive Democrat in November. Choose wisely my informed voter!

The “authorities” do not cooperate. CNN, ABC etc. would have to hire translators and on-scene reporters, who would be operating at great risk. It is difficult to insert or identify such people. Real news agencies used to do these things because their readers would benefit from being informed. Such reports might answer - How great is the risk of global conflict? Should we prepare? What will happen to oil prices? (by the way this is why they have plateaued.) Is regime change possible? Would that bring peace to the region?
