You can check your voter-registration-precinct (which IS different from your county-commissioner precinct) online at VoteTexas.gov, or [Elections.MyWoodCounty.com](https://elections.mywoodcounty.com), or by calling the Wood County Elections Office at 903.763.2400 during business hours.

Note that PRIOR to 3/3, all voters in Wood County are able to vote at Carroll Green Civic Ctr, even if you do not live in Precinct 1-1, but on 3/3 only those in Precinct 1-1 can vote at that location. Workers inside any of the polling-places can help direct you to the correct location, if needed.

(If you live in a DIFFERENT county in Texas, or if you live in Wood County that is NOT within Texas, check with local officials for where you should be voting.)

Shortly after the primary election, there will be precinct-conventions and the county-convention:

>>> Wood County **precinct-conventions** – March 28th 2026, Carroll Green Civic Center, Quitman check-in at 8:30am, all fourteen precinct-conventions will convene at 9am.

>>> Wood County **county-convention** – March 28th 2026, Carroll Green Civic Center, Quitman.

Check-in at ~1:30pm, the county-convention will gavel in and convene at 2pm.

If you were voted in as a county-convention-delegate at your precinct-convention above, come!

You can bring good ideas to this afternoon meeting as well, and we vote on them there.

You will also choose people to be delegates & alternates to state convention (Houston in June), and you can run for that job yourself if you wish. We forward along all the best ideas, as well.
